

City of McCallsburg

The City Council of McCallsburg met on Monday, January 19th, 2009 at 7 pm, in the McCallsburg City Office for a budget workshop meeting. Mayor Loney called the meeting to order. Councilpersons Bill Lytle, David Muth, Ken Tiarks, and Jeff Wells were present. Councilman Scott Anderson arrived at 8 pm. Two representatives from the library board were also in attendance.

Lytle motioned and Wells seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes with Anderson absent.

Councilman Muth asked the library representatives about the grant of \$4,500 the library had received. Muth wanted to know how the money was going to be spent. Sue Peterson said the money had been designated for a lap top, large print books, newspapers, DVDs and magazine subscriptions. Muth showed concern about getting the materials from the library to the coffee shop. Kathy Origer said the grant items were only intended for use at the library not the coffee shop. Councilman Wells suggested that the Legion be able to check out materials such as the lap top. Origer suggested the city look to the Gates Foundation to provide a computer at the coffee shop. Peterson said she would look into getting a second subscription to The DesMoines Register for the McCallsburg library. The council thanked Origer and Peterson for their time.

The council requested that the City Clerk make inquiries about the city's TIF money and property taxes for the next budget meeting. The next budget meeting will be held February 2, 2009 after the regular council meeting.

Lytle motioned to adjourn the meeting; Muth seconded. All ayes.
