

## **City of McCallsburg**

The City Council of McCallsburg met on Thursday, May 8th, 2008 at 7 pm, in the McCallsburg City Office for a Budget Workshop. Mayor Loney called the meeting to order. Councilpersons Scott Anderson, Bill Lytle, David Muth, and Ken Tiarks were present. Jeff Wells was absent. Mark Jackson was in attendance along with two residents.

Lytle motioned and Anderson seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mark Jackson, who assisted the mayor and city clerk with the final draft of the budget, answered budget questions from the council members. After some discussion a final draft of the budget was agreed upon and a budget hearing is set for June 2, 2008.

Mayor Loney had two complaints about sump pumps brought up to him over the week. One concerned grey water being dump across the city street. This is a tile drainage issue and the mayor was instructed to tell the resident that the owner of the sump pump would fix the problem as soon as things dried up.

The second complaint was from a resident who was concerned about their neighbor's grey water running off into their yard. The council agreed that as long as the resident emptied their sump pump onto their own property there was nothing the city could do about where the water ran off.

Lytle motioned and Anderson seconded to adjourn. All ayes. Motion Carried.
