

City of McCallsburg

The City Council of McCallsburg met on Friday, November 14th, 2008 at 7 pm, in the McCallsburg City Office for a Council Meeting and TIF Workshop. Mayor Loney called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. Councilpersons Scott Anderson, David Muth, Ken Tiarks and Jeff Wells were present. Councilman Bill Lytle was absent. City Attorney Robert Huffer was in attendance.

Muth motioned and Tiarks seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor Loney was instructed to get a bid to redirect the power supply for the noon whistle and also to check the electricity on the city shed to see if it is three phase.

The city council decided the city's code on tractor trailer parking will not be changed.

Councilman Muth made a motion to approve a resolution to affirm the judgment by the Story County District Court that defines the dates in which the city is allowed to remove any abandoned property on Parcels 1, 3,5,6,7 and 8. Tiarks seconded the motion. On roll call voting aye: Anderson, Muth, Tiarks, Wells and Lytle by teleconference.

The approval of the Annual Financial Report was tabled until November 21st, 2008.

The work session was rescheduled to November 21st, 2008 when councilman Lytle could be in attendance.

Tiarks motioned and Wells seconded to adjourn. All ayes. Motion Carried.
