

City of McCallsburg

The City Council of McCallsburg met on Friday, November 21st, 2008 at 7 pm, in the McCallsburg City Hall for a Council Meeting and TIF Workshop. Mayor Loney called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. Councilpersons Scott Anderson, Bill Lytle, David Muth, Ken Tiarks and three citizens were present. Councilman Jeff Wells was absent.

Tiarks motioned and Anderson seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

After much discussion over Parcel #52 the council agreed to review the ordinance related to semi truck parking. The clerk was instructed to get information from other cities on their semi truck ordinances. The clerk was also instructed to ask City Attorney to attend the next council meeting to advise in any revisions to the ordinance.

The clerk was instructed to get a copy of the letter sent to Parcel #45 from the City Attorney. The council asked Mayor Loney to ask Sheriff's Deputy Mortvedt to speak with the owners of Parcel #45, and to also ask Mr. Mortvedt who he would suggest remove the junk on the property. The council tabled any further action on Parcel #45 until the December 1st council meeting.

Councilman Lytle made a motion to approve the Annual Financial Report for 2008. Councilman Tiarks seconded the motion. On roll call voting aye: Anderson, Lytle, Muth, Tiarks with Wells absent.

The council went into a work session to complete the TIF report.

The clerk was instructed to check on the insurance payment for the fire department and to bill them accordingly.

Lytle motioned and Muth seconded to adjourn. All ayes. Motion Carried.
