The City Council of McCallsburg met on Monday, April 7, 2014 at 7:00 pm, in the McCallsburg City Hall for the regular monthly meeting. Mayor Pro Tem Bill Lytle called the meeting to order. Councilpersons David Muth, Chris Erickson, Scott Anderson and Kevin Lull were present. Mayor Wallace Loney was absent. Sheriff's Deputy Andrew Boeckman, Gail Springer, Vern Nelson, Brian and Elizabeth Wilson were also in attendance.

Councilman Muth made a motion to approve the agenda, the minutes from the March 3, 2014 regular meeting and the financial reports. Erickson seconded the motion. All eyes motion passed.

Mayor Pro Tem Lytle asked for citizens input on the budget. There was no input by citizens. There were no Committee Reports or Mayor remarks. The clerk informed the council about the Story County Economic Development Group meeting. The city has received a grant for the new city sign from them. McCallsburg will have to pay an annual fee to the State Auditor. The city will be given an audit sometime in the next 7 years with the fee helping to cover the audit cost. City Hall would be closed on Thursday 4/10/2014 because the clerk would be in meetings the rest of the week.

Councilman Muth made a motion to pass Resolution 14-07 for the FY14-15 Budget. Councilman Erickson seconded the motion. The motion passed on roll call vote:

Sheriff's Deputy Boeckman stated that several substations have been broken into. People have been stealing wire. All cars allowed in the area of substation should be clearly marked. If anyone sees something suspicious they are to call the Sheriff's Department.

Gail Springer wanted to talk to the council about the dog leash law for the city. She stated that there are numerous dogs that are running loose & not on a leash or in a fenced in yard. The council asked the clerk to make copy of city ordinance on restraint of dogs and mail them with a letter stating the consequences for not following the city ordinance.

Gail Springer also wanted to know when the city water looping project would begin this year. Mayor Pro Tem Lytle said it would start as soon as the frost was out of the ground. The council was wondering how to proceed with water looping project on the east side of town.

Elizabeth and Brian Wilson discussed with the council on buying 1 or 2 lots by the school from the city to build a house. The council said they would be in contact with the Wilson's on the matter.

The council is doing a walk around town on April 28th, 2014 so they can set a date sometime in May for a city wide cleanup. The clerk would have to get dumpsters delivered and put posters up.

There was also discussion on raking of rocks off of the grass left from the snow plows during the winter. It needed to be done before the grass begins to grow.

The council also discussed the letter from the Sheriff on paying last year's rates. They decided to table it and discuss it at next month's meeting. The council discussed the Fire Station gutters.

The next City Council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday May 6th, 2014 at 7:00pm at McCallsburg City Hall.

Councilman Muth made a motion to adjourn. Anderson seconded the motion. All ayes; motion passed.
