

## City of McCallsburg

The City Council of McCallsburg met on Monday June 17, 2013 at 6:30 pm, in the McCallsburg City Hall for a special meeting. Councilpersons Scott Anderson, Bill Lytle and David Muth were present. Councilman Chris Erickson arrived at 7:00 pm. Councilwoman Robin Pruisner was absent. Charlie Dissell from Story County Planning and Zoning and Kevin Jacobson were also in attendance.

Anderson made a motion to approve the agenda. Muth seconded the motion. All ayes, motion passed with Erickson and Pruisner absent.

The council discussed areas they would do road work this year. Anderson stated he would look into the price on asphalt millings to use on some roads.

The council discussed cleaning out tiles on the north side of Dubois, the north side of 4<sup>th</sup> street and along an alley off of Dubois by North 6<sup>th</sup>.

The council instructed the clerk to place a notice in the newsletter reminding residents that sump pumps are not to be discharged into the sanitary sewer.

The council discussed work that needed to be done to the water lines. Jacobson stated he would speak to Central Iowa Water about boring under the highway.

Anderson made a motion to approve the bid from Gray's Painting in the amount of \$3,280.00 for painting the east side of the fire station. Muth seconded the motion. All ayes, motion passed with Pruisner absent.

Discussion about projects in the city park was tabled until the July meeting.

Discussion on the new accounting system was tabled until the July meeting.

Lytle made a motion to adjourn. Muth seconded the motion. All ayes; motion passed with Pruisner absent.
